First 30 candidates will be called for interview based on the aggregate marks of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Year professional examination of MBBS as well as performance at the time of interview for further details refer to website [www.dcaimaging.org](http://www.dcaimaging.org)

- 1) Diwan Chand Satya Pal Aggarwal Imaging Research Centre is recognized for training of the post graduates for National Board of Examination in Radio-diagnosis.
- 2) Requisite number of candidates for Post Primary and Post DMRD will be taken for DNB (Radio-diagnosis) course every year starting in January.

3) **Duration of Course**

Duration of the course will be two years for those candidates who have done their DMRD in the discipline of the allied sciences in a recognized institution. The duration of course for graduates with no experience of house job will be three years.

4) **Requirements for admission**

Candidates seeking admission to this course should fulfill the following conditions:

- a) Candidates must have completed satisfactorily one year of compulsory rotating internship after passing the final M.B.B.S. examination and must have registration with the state Medical Council / M.C.I.
- b) For enrollment to three years course, the candidate is required to have done one year's housemanship / 1<sup>st</sup> year Junior Residency out of which preferably a minimum of six months period should be in the subject concerned.
- c) For enrollment to two years' course, the candidate is required to have passed DMRD in radiodiagnosis from a recognized university.

5) **Registration of applications for admission**

- a) Application in the prescribed form (copy enclosed) duly filled in and completed in all respects should reach the Director on or before.....  
(The candidates who are in service may send advance copy of the application completed in all respects where as the original copy should be routed through the employer).
- b) The completed application must also be accompanied by attested copies of the under mentioned certificates.
  - i) M.B.B.S.
  - ii) Detailed marks certificate of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and Final M.B.B.S. Examinations.
  - iii) House Job/1<sup>st</sup> year Junior Residency certificate from the Medical superintendent / Head of the Institution concerned indicating the date of starting and completion of period of house job / junior Residency.
  - iv) High School / Higher Secondary certificate for verification of date of birth.
  - v) Registration Certificate from State Medical Council or M.C.I.

**Note: No original certificate should be sent with the application form.**

- c) Application forms which are incomplete in any respect shall be rejected.
  - d) An interview will be held for selection after short-listing of candidates for the admission to the course. The candidates will be informed of the date and place of interview as given in the advertisement.
  - e) The candidates shall not be allowed to join the course unless the original certificates are produced at the time of interview.
- 6) The selected candidates after joining will work as Junior Residents in Radio diagnosis and will be paid monthly stipend as per the centre rules. They will be required to sign an agreement before joining the course.

**7) Confirmation of admission**

The admission of the candidate shall be provisional in the first instance. The Office Incharge after three months of the commencement shall submit through the Co-ordinator a report to the Chairman/Director, regarding the performance of the candidate. If the performance is stated to be satisfactory his provisional admission shall be confirmed. If the performance is not found satisfactory, the admission shall be cancelled and the candidate will be informed within one month of the receipt of the report of the Office Incharge.

**8) During the course of training the candidate will be required to:**

- a) Write a thesis duly certified by his/her guide. The thesis will be submitted four months prior to the examination along with application for appearing in the final examination of the National Board. The candidate's eligibility to appear in the final examination will depend on the completion of the required period of training and acceptance of the thesis. The subject of the thesis will be decided within three months of the candidate's admission for training to enable him to have adequate time for completion.
- b) The candidate will be required to maintain the performance record (Log Book) of minimum of twenty cases. The candidate would be required to bring the performance record duly certified at the time of practical examination failing which they will not be allowed to take the practical examination. The log book is made as per the specimen sent by the National Board.
- c) The post graduate training programme would broadly include lectures/demonstrations in basic sciences, case presentation, faculty lectures/symposia seminars, journal club meetings, radiology discussions clinical meetings and video cassettes sections.
- d) The trainee shall not resign his/her appointment without completing the postgraduate course to which he or she has been admitted. The cost of damages of the equipment during the tenure of training will be deducted from the security if the damage is due to negligence.
